To be qualified for the WMA scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a high school or GED (General Education Diploma) graduate,
- Be enrolled fulltime (12 or more credit hours or clock hour equivalent), or be enrolled part-time (6 or more credit hours or clock hour equivalent), if employed in manufacturing,
- Attend any university, community college or technical college in Kansas, and
- U.S citizen or Legal US Resident with a Green Card & Resident of Kansas.
